From: 2:00 PM to 4:30 PM The Red Bull Youth America's Cup was created in San Francisco in 2013 to attract the next generation of sailors. This year's competition takes place in Bermuda from June 12-21. Six youth crews will compete through their affiliation with the current America's Cup teams and up to 10 additional teams will be selected. The first qualifying race takes place June 12-13. There will be up to eight teams competing as a fleet to decide which four teams will compete with the winning four teams from the second qualifier race in the finals.
