This is our second and last newsletter before the 2003 Bermuda 1-2.

We have scheduled a Skippers' Forum and Shore Party for 22 March 2003.

I have already received a number of applications and the chat is that there may be a bigger turnout than in 2001.

Gulf Stream/Weather Seminar

As mentioned in the schedule above, we have a seminar scheduled for the same day as the Skippers' Forum and Shore Party on 22 March. This should start at 1:30 PM at the Newport Yacht Club and go to about 3:00 PM and is open to all. Jennifer Clark is an Oceanographer and Dane, her husband, is a Meteorologist. They have worked together since 1980. Using infrared imagery, satellite altimetry data, and surface isotherm data, oceanographic analyses are produced and available for the Gulf Stream. They provide this information to sailboat racers for a fee, of course. They will be doing a seminar on the Gulf Steam and weather and in the process will describe their products and charts for studying the configuration and movement of the stream and eddies over time. It should be very interesting even to a close to shore guy like myself. Jennifer and Dane will be staying for the rest of the evening and joining us for the Shore Party so will be available for side discussions. Claudio has been working with Ellen and Team Kingfisher for the past 4 years and was head of her sleep management training program in preparation for the Vendée Globe."
