The Notice of Race as well as an Amendment have gone out and are available on the website for download. May 01: Non assigned reserved Race Numbers become available

- May 30: Deadline for arrival in Newport of first-time entrants & returnees with new boats
- May 31: Bermuda One-Two Skipper's Welcome Party
- June 01: Bermuda One-Two Skipper Send Off Party
- June 03: Newport to Bermuda Start
- June 16: Bermuda to Newport Start
- June 25: Awards in Newport

UPCOMMING SEMINARS

SLEEP SEMINAR: We have been running this for the past several races and it has been well received. Dr. Claudio Stampi will be conducting the Sleep Seminar (9 April) at the Newport Yacht Club. We currently have fourteen people signed which is a good number.

HANDS ON SURVIVAL CLASS: Life Raft + Survival Equipment (LRSE) has a Hands On Survival Class scheduled for Sunday 6 March (the day after the Skippers' Forum/Party) and have reserved ten spots for Bermuda One-Two skippers. This will be a US SAILING sanctioned event. I currently have six people that

have expressed interest in this class and there is room for more. The cost is \$225 per person. This is open to anyone. Please give a call to LSRE to confirm your spot in this Hands On Survival Class. FIRST AID COURSE: For those that need to brush up on their First Aid, a course will be given at the Newport Yacht Club earlier in the day of the Skippers' Forum/Party. Currently I have 9 people interested. It is open to anyone. I don't have the cost yet but I'm told it isn't much.

DOUBLEHANDED OCEAN RACING TROPHY

This year's Bermuda One-Two race again can be used as input to the DH-ORT for those boats that provide an Endorsed IRC certificate in addition to all the other Bermuda One-Two requirements. These boats will be scored as a group, in addition to the Bermuda One-Two PHRF scoring, by TIME-ON-TIME using the Endorsed IRC rating and the results will be provided to the DH-ORT officials. These results in no way affect results of the Bermuda One-Two event and no trophies will be awarded to this grouping of boats as part of the Bermuda One-Two event. We have had only one entrant that participated in this, Bjorn Johnson in 2007.

POTENTIAL 2011 BERMUDA ONE-TWO SKIPPERS

We have received 4 applications for this year's race to date. Given the amount of people, especially new people, that have said they plan on racing, we could approach 50 boats this year.
